

Summer Central 2009!

(Children entering Kindergarten in the year 2009 are not eligible to attend Summer Central 2009)

Who: Summer Central 2009 is available to students attending the Burlington Elementary Schools who are entering grades 1 through 6 in August 2009.

Where: The Francis Wyman Elementary School. The program uses two large areas with access to a complete kitchen, private bathrooms, the gym, the computer lab, the playground, and a private entrance for picking-up and dropping-off children.

When: The program will operate from June 22, 2009 through August 14, 2009. The start date of the program may be affected by the number of snow days used during the school year. We will be closed from August 17, 2009 until the beginning of school unless otherwise notified. Program hours are from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Cost: Summer Central 2009 does not charge registration, membership, or additional fees for special programs, field trips, transportation, or snacks.

Children must enroll in Summer Central 2009 for a minimum of three weeks.

Staff: The Summer Central 2009 is staffed by experienced elementary school teachers, child care providers, and assistants. A ratio of 10 children per instructor is maintained.

Activities: We have a busy summer planned! Our weekly schedule will include field trips, as well as weekly swimming, the Book Worm Movie Club, music, sports, the theater, etc. In addition, we will be traveling around Burlington to the library, and to Simonds Park. Under normal circumstances, there are no additional costs for field trips, activities, transportation, or admission fees.

To enroll your child in the Summer Central 2009: Please complete the registration form on the following page. Registrations will be accepted on a first come first served basis, however, preference will be given to children enrolling in the 5 day per week program and to children attending the program in its entirety. **Children must enroll in the program for a minimum of three weeks and schedules changes must be made in writing before May 31, 2009 (no exceptions, please). Deposits will be applied toward tuition for the first week of Summer Central. Registrations for the Summer Central will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Children must enroll in the program for a minimum of three weeks. Preference will be given to children enrolling in the program five days per week, and to children attending the program in its entirety. Schedule changes must be made in writing before May 31, 2009 (no exceptions, please). Receipt of registration constitutes a child's enrollment in Summer Central 2009 unless otherwise notified. Deposits are not refundable unless the opening requested is not available.
